Make a nature crown

Have you ever wondered what it feels like to wear a royal crown?

A crown is a symbolic headdress worn by a monarch, which represents power, glory and honour. It is usually made of precious metals and jewels, but a crown doesn't have to be made using valuable materials. Let's use nature to create a crown instead!



What to do

- 1. Gather your own 'gems' to make a crown. While you are out walking, have a look around to see what natural items you can collect. You might find fallen leaves, flowers, lightweight twigs or seed cases. Gather a range of items and take them home to decorate your own crown. Check with an adult before picking flowers!
- 2. Ask somebody in your family to measure the circumference of your head and cut a strip of sturdy paper or card to the correct size, allowing an extra few centimetres at each end.
- 3. Arrange and stick your natural treasures onto the strip of paper and finish by taping it together to fit around your head.
