## Making flowers

Age 6+ (with some adult supervision)

## You will need


Coloured paper or felt
Buttons
Scissors
Sheet of A4 thick paper or card
Sticky tape
PVA glue






## What to do

I. Lay out your paper or felt and cut out a selection of flower shapes in different sizes. Cut five small shapes and five big shapes. You can make them as simple or as fancy as you like!



- 2. Lay out all of the big flower shapes, and add a small dot of glue in the middle of each of them.
- 3. Next, sit a small flower shape on top of each of the big ones so that the glue sticks them both together.
- 4. Now, place a small dot of glue in the middle of each of the small flower shapes, and place a button on it.



- 5. Leave them to dry for 15 minutes.
- 6. Finally, use some sticky tape to attach each flower to a paper straw. Put them in a glass or vase and enjoy your paper flowers!
