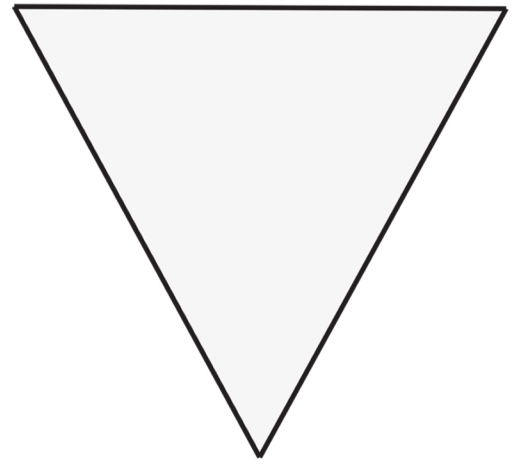
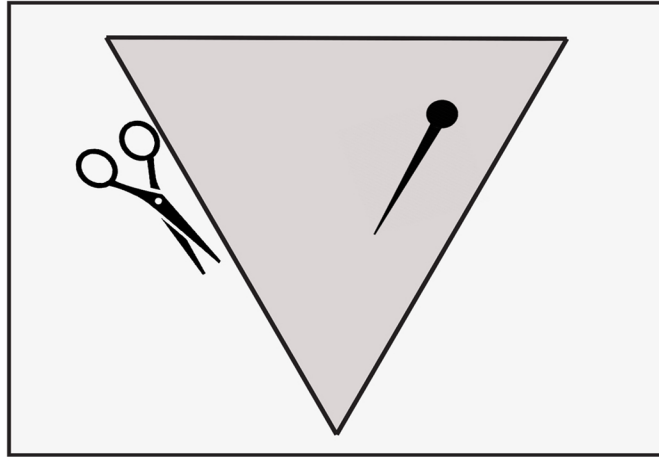
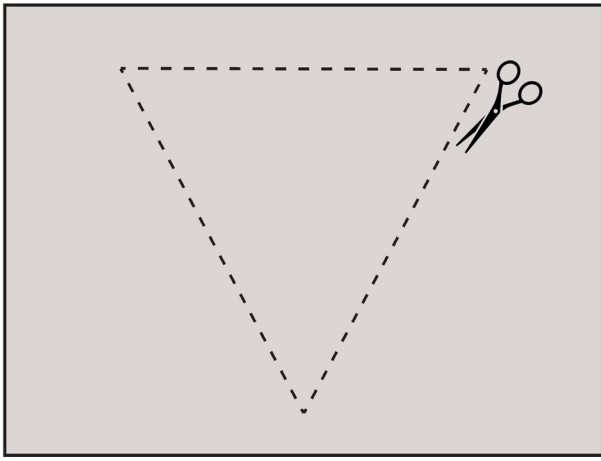
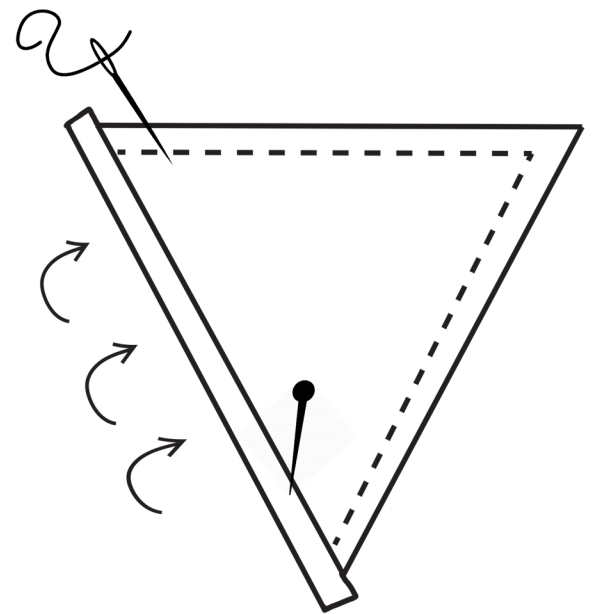
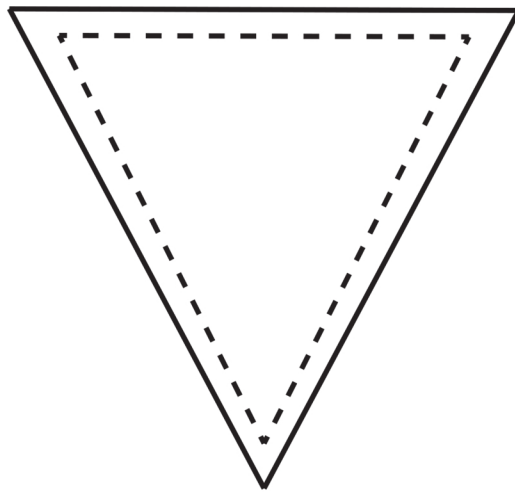
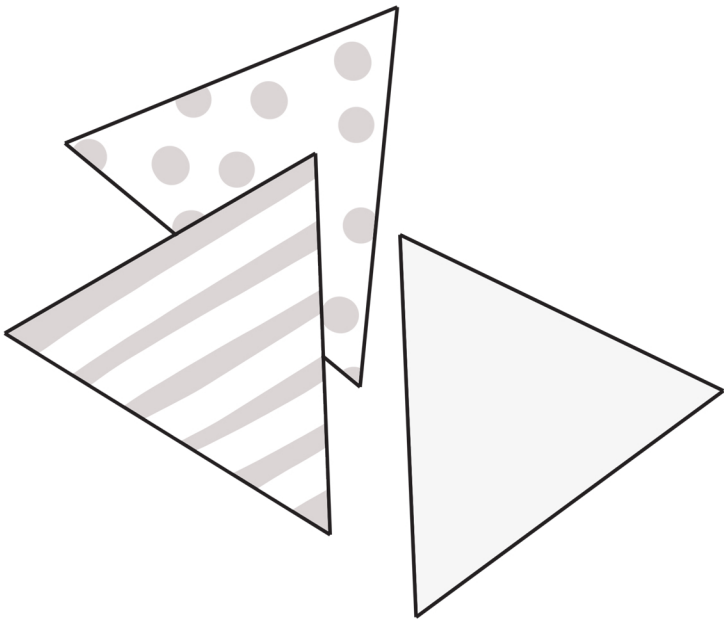


# Fabric Bunting



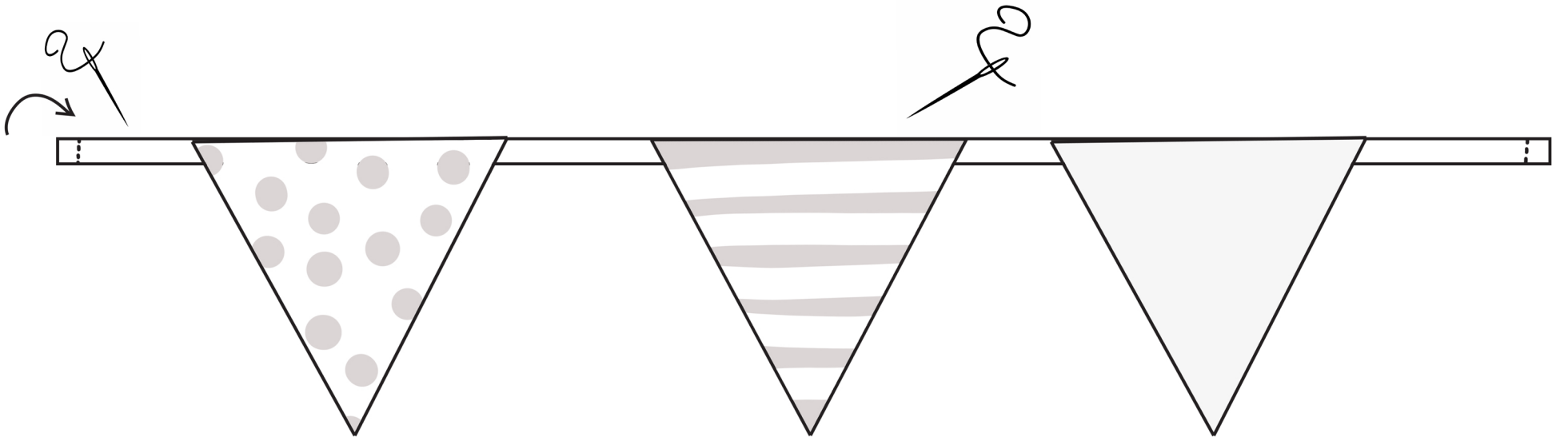
1. Choose the size of triangles you would like for your bunting. Draw your triangle on a piece of card to create a template. (Remember that the triangles on your bunting will be slightly smaller than the template due to the hem.)

2. Pin the template to a piece of fabric and cut out the triangle.



3. Repeat step 2 until you have the desired number of triangles for your length of bunting.

4. Hem the sides of the triangles by folding in the sides all the way round by 1 cm and pinning in place. Sew the hem in place so you have a neat edge and can't see where the material has been cut.



5. Iron the triangles flat, so that they look neat.

6. Take a length of ribbon to sew your triangles to. Sew the triangles to the ribbon spacing them evenly. Fold the ribbon over at each end, creating a 1 cm hem and sew in place to prevent fraying. If you don't have ribbon you can use a length of fabric instead and hem it to prevent fraying.
